Tinny Supplied Option

The idea is you can fly in, and we have the large camping gear ready for you and you fly in with just your backpack.

We'll supply per Tinny - esky, table, chairs, bbq hot plate, shovel, portable camping toilet.

You'll need to bring:

Get gear designed for hiking if you can as it is lighter and more compact. Facebook marketplace is a great place to find second hand gear that often has rarely been used. I have put some suggestions below if you do not have this gear for where it can be bought and what sort. Bring a 2 man hiking tent for yourself will be a lot lighter and smaller than a swag and will give you protection from mozzies and the rain.

Temperatures:

In October/November will be average temp of 13-28 degrees, with an occasional hotter day in the low 30s. The water will be cold to swim in coming off winter. Average days of rain is 3 per month, with 10 hours of sunlight per day.

Per person

- Hiking tent
- Head torch (+ spare torch)
- Sleeping bag
- Sleeping matt/air mattress (get something comfortable as you will be on it for 7 days)
- Clothes (pack hat, sunglasses, bathers and clothes for cooler weather and rain just in case)
- USB Battery banks and/or hiking solar panel to charge your phone.
- 12V & 240V chargers for phones etc
- Eating utensils (plate, mug, knife/fork/spoon)
- Personal medication
- Insect repellent
- sunscreen

Per Tinny

- First Aid Kit
- 3 x3 tarp (& cord) for cooking under in unlikely event of rain. No need for poles you can find trees to tie it between and use sticks for poles
- Hiking stove gas or wood. You can't fly with gas, you'll be able to buy gas canisters in Mildura before you cast off. You can cook over the wood fire most of the time, but this is handy to make a quick cup of coffee or in case you can't find firewood, there is a total fire ban or the firewood is wet.



- Pot to boil water in
- Cooking utensils (tongs, egg flip)
- Camping lantern
- Mozzie repellant

Optional to pack:

• Cameras, drones, portable speakers, card/board games. Fishing gear.





BYO Tinny

Suggested. Everything listed above, plus

- Portable camping toilet, esky, table, chairs, bbq hot plate, shovel, etc, PVC pop up bin x2 (keeps your rubbish bag from getting holes in it and leaking in your tinny. Suggest one for rubbish and one for recycling). le <u>https://www.bcf.com.au/p/pvc-pop-up-bin/M296872.html</u>. - Peg/stake to hammer in to tie your boat to if no trees where you camp

Portable Toilets

In order to make sure we don't leave toilet paper all over the river bank, and don't piss off the locals so they never let us back, we must bring portable toilets. There are dump points for the house boats provided along the river where you can empty the toilet.

Mildura Shopping List

Suggested list to Buy in Mildura at Woolworths and BCF on Sunday morning

- Gas canisters
- Drinking water (buy the 10L containers)
- Coffee bags <u>https://www.woolworths.com.au/shop/productdetails/283136/robert-timms-italian-espresso-style-cof</u> <u>fee-bags</u>
- Ice
- Beer/drinks etc. Suggest cans not bottles for minimising the volume of our rubbish so we don't overflow the bins of the towns we visit when we empty the rubbish out of our tinny
- Food & Drinks
- Cooking oil
- Fire lighters & lighter
- Garbage bags
- Fuel (91 unleaded)
- Two stroke oil

You should be able to find firewood along the river. No need to buy any
